SCRIPTURE 1 THESSALONIANS 1:2-7

We give thanks to God always for you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. For we know brethren, beloved by God that he has chosen you. For our Gospel came to you not only in word but also in power and in the Holy Spirit with full conviction. You know what sort of people we were among you for your sake. And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, receiving the word in great affliction, with joy from the Holy Spirit, so that you became a model for all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Checking in, on a scale of 1-5, how motivated do you feel to invest and invite someone to Church? Why do you answer as you do?
2. What are your thoughts on finding a teammate to help you share your faith? Who is someone in your family or workplace that you can team up with so that you can share your faith with others?
3. Read aloud 1 Thessalonians 1:4. What thoughts or emotions come to mind when you hear that you have been chosen by God? How does this truth help motivate you to share your faith with others?
4. Who is someone you are investing in through the course of this series? What good deeds or acts of service can you do in your home, workplace, or school environment that will allow you to share the Gospel?
5. Read aloud 1 Thessalonians 1:5. What convictions do you have about your faith? How would you share them with others?
