SCRIPTURE 1 THESSALONIANS 2:7B-8 & 2:13

1 Thessalonians 2:2-7 We were gentle among you, as a nursing mother cares for her children. With such great affection for you, we were determined to share with you not only the gospel of God, but our very selves as well, so dearly beloved had you become to us.

1 THESSALONIANS 2:13 And for this reason too we give thanks to God unceasingly, that in receiving the word of God from hearing us, you received not a human word but, as it truly is, the word of God, which is now at work in you, who believe.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read 1 Thessalonians 2:8. Who is someone dear to you or close to you who lives disconnected from Christ and his Church? On a scale of 1-5, how determined are you to share the Gospel with them?
2. How is your relationship with the people you are trying to reach? What does it mean to you to share the Gospel relationally?
3. What verses of Scripture, parables, or passages grab your heart and you want others to know them? If helpful read some of the verses below and ask the group to mention what resonates with them.
4. Read 1 Thessalonians 2:13. As you end the meeting, go around the group and thank God in advance that he will use you to help someone you dearly love to know the good news of the Gospel. Have each member name the person they want to reach.
