### SCRIPTURE MATTHEW 28:16-20

**The Great Commission** <sup>16</sup> But the eleven disciples proceeded to Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had designated to them. <sup>17</sup> And when they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some were doubtful. <sup>18</sup> And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. <sup>19</sup> Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to follow all that I commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”
