

Sample Invitations to Small Group

What are some ways we can invite those in our church community and those outside of our church community to check out small groups? Our approach to sharing our faith is simple:

1. **Connect** with the person you hope to invite to your small group.
2. **Invest** time and attention into this person, let them know they're loved.
3. **Invite** when the time is right.

Depending on who you want to invite, you can approach it differently based on their relationship with Nativity and church in general. This one pager will give you some helpful tips and sample invitation scripts.

To those in church, but not connected in Small Groups:
