SPECIFIC VENUES OR CHECK IN

- Monday Early Experience. Guests attending the Early Experience should be directed

 begins at 11:00 AM, and those guests should be in the Ministry Suite by 10:50 AM. Be
 ready to greet each guest warmly and clearly direct them to the suite.
- Concelebrants for Mass. All Priests and any Priest who arrives to celebrate mass should check in with Tina in the registration tent in front of the building.
- **Registration Tent.** This will be outside in the plaza.
- **Breakouts.** View the schedule. There will be breakouts in the classrooms, theatre and sanctuary.
- Rebuilt Lounge. In the glass link between the Next Gen lobby and the concourse (entry way).
- Rebuilt tables and demos. In the Vision Cafe
