Position Summary:

The Rebuilt Parish Ministry Coordinator is a part-time position dedicated exclusively to supporting the Rebuilt Parish Ministry. This role is responsible for overseeing the full minister lifecycle within Rebuilt Parish, from recruitment and training to placement, tracking, and ongoing care. The coordinator ensures that ministers are well-formed, supported, and joyfully integrated into ministry teams. The position also includes event planning, database management, and leadership development within the ministry. This role isn't just about coordinating volunteers; it's about equipping the saints for the work of ministry (Ephesians 4:12).

Key Responsibilities:

Recruitment & Onboarding

- Plan and conduct regular interest meetings for prospective ministers.
- Manage the application process and oversee background checks in compliance with parish/diocesan guidelines.
- Guide new ministers through onboarding and training processes.
- Place ministers into appropriate teams, coordinating with ministry leaders to fill needs and gaps.

Minister Formation & Training

- Develop and facilitate formation and training resources specific to the Rebuilt Parish Ministry.
- Work collaboratively with internal ministry leaders to ensure consistent and mission-aligned training.
- Create leadership development pathways and form a Rebuilt Parish Ministry leadership team.
- Support the spiritual well-being of ministers and encourage spiritual growth

Minister Support & Care

- Track each minister's progress from initial interest through full assimilation.
- Conduct regular check-ins with active ministers to assess their experience and support needs.

- Identify and share new ministry opportunities with current and potential ministers.
- Organize bi-annual appreciation events, such as a Christmas Party and Summer Happy Hour.

Administrative & Data Management

- Maintain accurate and up-to-date records in the Ministry Platform system.
- Track demographic information and engagement metrics for all ministers.
- Provide regular reports to the Rebuilt Parish Team on minister involvement, training completion, and team needs.

Preferred Qualifications

- Committed to the vision and values of the Rebuilt Parish Ministry.
- Strong interpersonal and organizational skills.
- Experience in volunteer or ministry coordination preferred.
- Comfortable with digital tools such as Google Suite, spreadsheets, and Zoom.
- Able to work independently and collaboratively in a fast-paced ministry environment.
- Availability to work occasional weekends or evenings for events or meetings.
