Title: Staff Coach

Department: Parish Transformation

Reports To Title: Director of Coaching/ Head of Parish Transformation

Hours: PT – 20 hours/wk

Location: Remote, based out of Timonium, Maryland; Will include some travel

Position Summary:

The Staff Coach plays a key role in supporting the transformation of Catholic parishes through parish and 1:1 coaching, and consulting in the Rebuilt model and anchors. This part-time position works directly with parish leaders to implement Rebuilt's model and offers strategic guidance and consulting. Coaches may also provide one on one leadership coaching. Coaches may assist with coaching related projects at times. Ideal candidates are experienced ministry leaders or consultants with coaching experience and with a passion for making disciples and a desire to walk alongside parishes in renewal.

Key Responsibilities:

Area 1- Parish Coaching & Consulting

- Serve as a lead coach for assigned parishes, providing 1:1 coaching to pastors and leaders using Rebuilt's coaching model.
- Guide parishes through Rebuilt's transformation process and key strategic initiatives.
- Support implementation of tools, processes, and priorities aligned with the parish's renewal goals.
- Provide mentorship to partner coach.
- Occasional visits to parishes and evaluation of weekend experience.
- Lead occasional Strategic offsites for parishes.

Area 2 - Collaboration & Learning

- Participate in biweekly coach meetings, and learning sessions and bi-annual in person training.
- Collaborate with the Head of Parish Transformation and other coaches to share best practices and ensure consistent efforts.

Area 3 - Ad Hoc Projects

- Contribute to the development or delivery of special projects as needed (e.g., resource development, course facilitation, internal initiatives).
- Provide insight, resources, or feedback to strengthen Rebuilt's offerings.

- Must have professional coaching experience and related certification.
- Demonstrated experience in parish ministry, leadership, or consulting.

- Strong interpersonal, communication, and listening skills.
- Self-starter with the ability to manage time and tasks independently.

- Familiarity with Rebuilt's vision and approach to parish renewal.
