### AFTER MASS


Join us in the Vision Café or Next Gen Lobby after Mass for photo opportunities with a fun display then head out to the Plaza for coffee or lemonade.

## Parking & Shuttle Service



Parking on Easter Sunday will be quick and efficient. In addition to our main parking lot, hundreds of parking spaces will be available along Ridgely Road. Shuttles will provide continuous service from 6:30am through 2pm. Taking the shuttle is an easy, hassle-free way to park. Drop-off is at our Vista Lane entrance.

### ACCESSIBLE PARKING & SEATING

Guests in need of accessible parking, please park on our main campus. When you pull into our driveway, turn on your hazard lights and follow the direction of our Parking Ministers. There will also be a drop-off area outside our main entrance. Each of our seating venues will have accessible seating. ## Children's Programs

**ALL STARS** (for ages 6 weeks to 6 years) Our program for young children is available during each Mass time on Easter Sunday. Guests and visitors are welcome; however, space is limited. Ask our Greeters how your kids can join.

**CRY LOFT** (for all ages) On our mezzanine level, we have a dedicated space for families who choose to keep their children with them. Families can see and hear everything and kids are free to roam and make all the noise they want. Ask our Host Ministers to direct you to the Cry Loft.

**FAMILY FRIENDLY SEATING** (for all ages) Please join us in the Pavilion, our family friendly video venue, as an extension of our Cry Loft area where Mass will be viewable via a TV screen. Ask our Host Ministers to direct you to the Pavilion.

**PRAISE PARTY** (for grades 1 to 5) Our Children's Liturgy of the Word, also known as Time Travelers, is transformed on Easter Sunday into a vibrant, over-the-top celebration we call Praise Party. Meet interesting characters from the Bible who introduce kids to the story of the first Easter and lead a celebration full of high-energy worship. Praise Party will be offered at all Easter Sunday Masses. All are welcome! Watch for the video instructions in Mass so your kids can join the party.
